Description

Between 800 and 1200, Galo Polychrome yielded to Mora Polychrome ceramics. The ornately decorated objects were probably produced in the southern Nicoya region, but have been found in Atlantic Watershed /Central Highlands sites due to active trading practices. The influence of Late Classic Maya Copador ware is apparent in the use of mat patterns figure types and feathered headdresses.
